## **General Information and Rules**

#### MEMBERSHIPS

All Canadian riders and owners must have a valid Gold sport license from EC as well as a provincial membership (OE).

If the Owner/Rider does not have a gold license but does have a silver or bronze license a one-time upgrade may be purchased.

If a temporary sport license is purchased, the individual must be a member of OE. There is a form available that must be filled out for a temporary license. No points will accumulate on a temporary membership. OHJA Membership is required for results to count towards OHJA Standings.

Anyone competing in an amateur class must have an EC Amateur Card.

CET membership is required to compete in the CET Medal. If offered

USEF membership is acceptable for non Canadian residents.

#### HORSE RECORDING

All horses must have an EC horse recording number and be up to date for the current year. Alternatively, a temporary horse registration may be purchased. In this case no points will be awarded. A valid USEF horse recording number is acceptable.

#### ENTRIES

Entries can be done online at www.horseshowsonline.com / For mobile use: www.mobile.horseshowsonline.com. Entries received after the closing date will be assessed a post entry fee. **SCRATCHES**: Any classes scratched prior to a class will not be charged. Any classes scratched once the class has begun will be charged the entry fee. Should a competitor scratch from the show with a vet certificate they will be charged the admin fee and scratch fee \$50. Stalls will not be refunded under any circumstances.

ADDS: Day of adds (if permitted) will be charged **\$10.00** in addition to the class fee.

**SHOW OFFICE:** During the show, the show office will open 60 min prior to the beginning of the first class and will remain open 30 min. after the conclusion of the show day. Leading up to the show the horse show email will be answered within 24 hours and any calls can be taken during regular business hours.

**ADMIN FEE:** Each horse will pay a **\$60** admin fee. There will be a 3% surcharge on all credit card transactions processed.

DRUG FEE: Each horse will pay the applicable \$8 Drug Fee

JUMP CANADA LEVY: Each competitor will pay the applicable JC levy \$20

**MEDIC/FACILITY FEE**: Each horse will pay a **\$ 25** medic fee to help cover the cost of medics on standby during the event.

**NIGHT WATCH FEE:** Each stabled horse will pay a **\$15** night watch fee.

JUMPER NOMINATION: Jr/Am 1.10+: \$130 Open Jumper 1.15 and above: \$150

**INCOMPLETE ENTRIES**: entries provided with no membership numbers etc. will be assessed a **\$25** charge.

**SHOW NUMBERS**: Show numbers will not be issued without secured form or payment (cash or open cheque).

Competitors must wear the show number at all times while mounted.

**PRIZE MONEY**: Prize money cheques will be issued upon checkout if applicable.

**HAY/BEDDING:** Hay and bedding must be pre ordered with stall requests. During the show hay and shavings orders will be accepted before noon on Saturday.

**TRAINER SPLITS:** Trainer splits must be completed and submitted to the show office by 10AM Saturday morning, otherwise all charges will be issued to the trainer.

RETURNED CHECKS: Checks returned for any reason will be subject to a 10% fee. (Minimum \$50)

**BEHAVIOR/SAFETY:** Any competitor or visitor at this event who is caught committing abuse to a horse or acting in an unsafe manner at any time will be asked to leave the property. No fees will be refunded.

**RINGS**: Indoor warm up (available in case of inclement weather) sand/GGT mix. All other rings are sand/GGT Fiber mix. Jumper Ring, 170x300 Hunter 1, 150x250 Hunter 2 150x250. Main warm up area is 200x200 and may be split. **LEASH LAW:** dogs are welcome however they must be well behaved and leashed at all times. Any dogs found loose will be assessed a **\$100** charge.

**MEDICAL WASTE:** All sharps must be disposed of properly and placed in the proper receptacles.

Protective headgear: Proper protective headgear must be worn by all riders at all times.

**CHECK OUT:** All Entries must be closed out and payments collected by the end of the horse show. A **\$25** Check out fee will apply to all unclosed accounts.

**SCHEDULE:** The management reserves the right to alter the schedule, including but not limited to canceling, combining or postponing any classes. Competitors will be given the most possible notice and the schedule will be kept as up to date as possible on www.horseshowsonline.com.

**NON-SHOWING HORSES**: Non Showing horses are welcome. They must be properly entered in the show. The fee for non-showing horses is **\$0**. This fee includes Warm up tickets.

**3RD PARTY SERVICES:** Any services such as vet and blacksmith must be settled directly with the service providers.

**DRESS CODE:** Solid colour polo shirts are permissible for jumper classes Thursday and Friday. Jackets are to be worn for classes Saturday and Sunday. Formal attire required for any specialty classes: Open Welcome. Grand Prix. **VEHICLES:** Golf carts and dirt bikes are permissible. They must be operated by licensed drivers. Any vehicle driven irresponsibly will be confiscated for the duration of the horse show.

#### STALLS

\*\*\*STALL RESERVATIONS DUE 2 WEEKS BEFORE THE BEGINNING OF EACH SHOW\*\*\* Stalls must be booked in writing using the Stall Reservation form available at www.tensixtystables.com. The cost of stalls will be \$175 for the week of the show. Day stalls are not available. Once booked, stalls will not be refunded. CAMPERS: Our facility is not equipped with utilities for campers at this stage. A few self contained campers are

permissible, they must be registered with the office

## **Equestrian Canada**

Statement of Principles

- Equestrian Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to the humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction. All Persons shall be committed to:
- upholding the welfare of all horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities;
- requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and compassion, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment;
- ensuring that all Equestrians including owners, trainers and competitors, or their respective agents, use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their own horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose;
- providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure;
- providing current information on Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Equines and other equine health and welfare initiatives;
- continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;
- requiring owners, trainers and competitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions;
- Actively promoting the development of and adherence to competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horse. The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person who is informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and competition procedures would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.

The TSS Classic competition is sanctioned as a: Gold competition member of Equestrian Canada 11 Hines Road, Suite 201, Ottawa, Ontario, K2K 2X1 and is governed by the rules of EC.

Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book.

All Canadian entries are required to hold both an EC passport and a valid EC horse license to compete, or if owned by a temporary sport license holder, a Temporary Horse Registration form must be purchased at each competition entered.

Any horse entered in any class at a competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location.

Per Article A801, every entry at an EC sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition. It is the responsibility of all individuals participating in any capacity in EC sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC constitution and the applicable rules of EC and the additional rules, if any, imposed by the competition. Do not participate in this EC- sanctioned competition in any capacity if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition.

Reminder that competition numbers must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise areas as well as in the competition ring. See Article A814

All horses attending Equestrian Canada sanctioned competitions must have met the requirements of Article A519, Vaccinations See Rules of Equestrian Canada, Section A, General Regulations, Article A519, Vaccinations. (A602.8)

When registering for EC sanctioned competitions, athletes must indicate the name of their coach on the entry form or specify that they are self coached. Coaches from other countries, must be in good standing with their home federation and must declare/have proof of insurance. See Rules of Equestrian Canada, Section A, General Regulations, Article 102, Safe Sport Environments. (A602.9)

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC Rules and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book all questions not covered by these rules shall be decided by the show management, whose decision will be final. (A602.2)

#### ARTICLE G108 AMATEUR STATUS

 All seniors competing in amateur classes at EC-sanctioned competitions must possess a current EC amateur card. Competitors in FEI-sanctioned competitions must comply with the FEI definition of amateur.
 A person competing in EC amateur classes must hold a valid EC senior sport license, have a current amateur card and adhere to the guidelines in the EC rule book

#### HUNTER CLASS RULES

**Short/ Long Stirrup**: Intended as an introduction to horses showing with junior riders not ready for the regular pony and hunter divisions. Ponies and horses may enter. Riders must be in their first or second year of showing and may cross enter into the Walk Trot and or "C" Equitation on the flat classes. Riders may not show in any other classes that require them to jump higher than 2". Riders are restricted from participation in the Children's Pony Division. Suitability is a factor. Horses or ponies may show in other classes with a different rider. This division will jump a course of hunter style jumps not to exceed 2' and no oxers. Jogging is at the discretion of show management. Short Stirrup may run concurrently with Long Stirrup.

Lead line: Open to riders 10 years old and under. Handlers must be over the age of 18.

Baby Green: The intention of this division is to provide a hunter division for green, young horses starting their

showing career. To maintain Baby Green Status, horses may not compete in any division in which the jumps exceed 2'9". Jogging is not required. Fences to be set a 2'9". This division is open to horses than have not competed in an EC sanctioned Gold or Silver competition or equivalent in any class requiring the entry to jump 2'9" prior to January 1st of the current year.

**Low Child/Adult Hunter**: 2'9 Open to all Children/Adult Amateur Riders (EC Definitions) Riders may not cross enter into any hunter class requiring them to jump over 2'9 or any jumper class requiring them to jump over 1.0m at the same show. No Jogging

Beginner Child/Adult: This division is intended for new riders learning how to show a hunter.

A beginner hunter is a Junior or Adult rider who has NEVER won 6 first place ribbons over fences at an EC or USEF competition (Provincial competitions and Combined Training not to count). These wins are LIFETIME achievements. Schooling Non-Pro and Short Stirrup not to count.

NEW FOR 2025: Winning your way out – Any competitor competing in this division should they win 6 first place ribbons, they will be allowed to remain in the division to the end of that calendar year. If the competitor has 6 first place ribbons prior to Jan 1st of the current calendar year they are no longer eligible to compete in this division and have won their way out. Children's and Adult Amateur rider designations are per EC rules, guidelines and limitations. Courses are made of hunter style jumps and set at a height not to exceed 2'6". Classes will be run per EC rules. Riders and horses may cross enter to other divisions for which they are eligible. Showing in this division will not affect a horse's eligibility. As entries warrant, Children's and Adults may be combined. Jogging for soundness at the discretion of Show Management.

**Children's Pony:** This division is a combined pony division to be judged on quality, movement, jumping style, manners and way of going. Lines will be set on a 12 foot stride. No in and out. Fence heights include: Small Pony – 2' Medium Pony – 2'3" Large Pony – 2'6" Division does not affect Green Pony status.

#### TSS Young Hunter- TSS Classic I/II

Class# 903 Model, Class# 904 U/S, Class# 906 O/F

A model, under saddle and over fences class restricted to Young Horses ages 3, 4 and 5-year olds. The Model Under saddle and over fences class are run and judged separately-scoring is not cumulative. Horses are not required to compete in all three classes.

**Model**: shown in hand; to be judged on conformation, manners, way of moving and soundness. 50% on movement and 50% on conformation.

**Under Saddle**: To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring; no hand-gallop; to be judged on conformation, manners, way of moving and soundness. 60% on movement and 40% on confirmation. **Over Fences**: The course will be set at 2ft 3" with no more than 8 jumps. To be judged on their jumping style, manners and way of going.

Registration for these classes must include valid copy of horse's papers for proof of age (Tattooed thoroughbreds without papers are eligible when a letter provided from a vet confirming the tattoo number and corresponding year of birth). To be eligible for the Top Canadian Bred must provide papers. Papers may be randomly checked by a show vet. Not open to ponies. Junior A, B and C riders must not ride or handle stallions per EC rule G105.

#### OHJA 2'6 Jr/Am (Classic I/II) Class # 557-560

Open to all Junior and Adult Amateur rider designations as per EC rules, guidelines, and limitations. Courses will be made up of hunter style jumps and set at a height not to exceed 2'6". To be shown over a course of at least eight (8) fences. Classes will be run per EC rules. Horse/Rider combinations may not cross enter any division requiring them to jump higher than 2'9". Showing in this division will not affect a horse's eligibility. Ribbons to 8th. No jogging required. All entries (rider and owner) must have a valid current OHJA membership to be considered for Provincial Year End Awards.

## OHJA Pony Classic (TSS Classic II only)

### Class # 1004

Open to Ponies in the core Small, Medium and Large Pony Divisions. The course will be set at appropriate pony heights and distances with a minimum of 12 jumps. The Classic may contain multiple single jumps, roll backs, bending lines or longer lines. Judged numerically out of 100 on quality, movement, jumping style, manners, and way of going. First rounds will be score from 4th O/F in pony division. The top 20 will return for second classic round. Ponies in the Classic must be sound. Jogging in hand or trotting a closing circle is required to confirm. This Classic will count for points (OHJA Provincial Standings/Year End Awards and National Rankings) EC Article G314.

### 2'6 Jr/Am Development Derby (Classic I) Class #1008

### Class Conditions to be printed in prize list:

To be shown over one round. Fences 2"6' with Options to 2"9'. Course may include hunter classic, handy hunter, and field hunting fences elements. Bonus points will be available for use of options and additional bonus points will be available for handiness at the judge's discretion. Open Numerical score.

#### All Other Hunter Classes:

Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book.

# EC SPORT LICENSING 2025 SAFETY, INCLUSIVITY, & EXCELLENCE

Your guide to the latest updates for the competition season in Canada

IMPORTANT CHANGES have been implemented to enhance the safety and inclusivity of equestrian sport. Whether you're an athlete, parent, coach, official, or competition staff, your role is crucial in upholding these standards. Here's what you need to know:

#### SAFE SPORT TRAINING PREREQUISITE:

 The two free EC Safe Sport training modules must be completed before purchasing a Sport Licence. Check your training status on MyEC by clicking on the ECampus button.

### DISCONTINUED TEMPORARY LICENCES AND TEMPORARY HORSE REGISTRATIONS:

 Temporary EC Sport Licences are now discontinued at competitions. All riders, owners, and coaches must possess an EC Sport Licence to participate in events. All horses must have a Horse Recording where level and division require.

#### **WALABLE SHOW LEVEL UPGRADES:**

 Explore higher-level competitions with temporary upgrades via your MyEC Portal. Note: National Rankings Points are not tabulated for upgraded results.

#### COACH STATUS REQUIREMENTS:

- All coaches at EC-sanctioned events require EC Licensed Coach Status. For upgrading from Registered to Licensed Status, coaches can apply for a Temporary Coach Status (TCS) to fulfill the requirement for each event.
- New for 2025: A TCS may be purchased conveniently online via the MyEC Portal only. Each TCS is valid for a single event.

#### EMPOWERINGSELF-COACHED ATHLETES.

 Athletes without a coach on-site can declare themselves as self-coached by providing their name and EC Sport Licence number on their entry form. Coaches that are not present at the event with the athlete are not to be listed on the entry form. When registering for EC sanctioned competitions. athletes must indicate the name of their coach on the entry form or specify that they are selfcoached. Coaches from other countries, must be in good-standing with their home federation and must declare/have proof of insurance.
